

Chem-TX (Item # 4001)

To Support the Mobilization and Elimination of Petrochemical Toxins

What is Chem-TX?

Chem-TX is an herbal combination designed to assist the body in its mobilization and removal of toxic chemicals especially those of alcohol or petrochemical origin. Assisting the body's natural attempts to eliminate toxic chemicals Chem-TX supplies the herbal and nutritional foundation for a safe and effective detoxification process.

Cleansing and detoxifying our bodies has become a necessity for many of us. Chem-TX contains herbs and minerals known for their ability to chelate (bond with) petrochemical toxins thereby detoxifying, revitalizing, and toning the body. This unique combination of herbs has a cleansing effect on the liver and other eliminative organs, giving us a chance to rest and clear out the accumulated toxins.

Dosage: Take two vegi-caps, twice daily or as directed by a health care practitioner. Cleansing formulations like this should be limited to no more than 30 days. People over 250 lbs. can take up to 3 caps – 3 times daily.

- ~ It is essential to drink lots of clean, healthy water while detoxifying petrochemical toxins-no less than eight – 8 oz. glasses per day.
- ~ As with any supplement, achieving the best results may require a change in lifestyle. Keeping a healthy diet, exercising the body and mind, limiting alcohol, sugar, and caffeine consumption, avoiding cigarette smoke, and using supplements are just a few ways to improve overall health. Foods of choice include: Organic, local produce (fruits and vegetables), whole grains and legumes, and fermented foods like yogurt, kefir, miso, and sauerkraut.

Ingredients Explained

Aloe Leaf - Aloe, with its numerous species throughout the world, has a colorful history as a medicinal plant being used by traditional herbalists as well as allopathic physicians. The most common use of Aloe, familiar to most of us, is as a treatment for burns, skin injuries and insect bites. It has a reputation of being able to draw out infection from injuries to the skin and muscle. Other traditional uses include; increasing menstrual flow, laxative or strong cathartic (an agent that helps to empty the bowels). Aloe aids the body's natural defenses in mobilizing and eliminating poisonous compounds and elements. Recent studies on with aloe validate the use of this herb as an anti-oxidant and gentle body cleanser.

Cats Claw (Una de Gato) - In Peru, Cats Claw has a long traditional history as a treatment for a host of diseases, including; asthma, arthritis, gastritis, dysentery, tumors, skin ailments, many types of infection, urinary tract inflammation, female hormonal imbalances and blood purifier. Studies show that this herb has the ability to reduce DNA damage in the cells ... this is of particular interest to those who suffer from cancer.

Coptis Chinensis - In Chinese herbal medicine, Coptis has been used for centuries to eliminate heat-dominated illnesses like abdominal fullness, emaciation, fire-caused diarrhea, abdominal cramps, hematemesis, epistaxis, "red" eyes, canker sores, skin sores, scabies and as a general blood purifier. In Western countries, Coptis' main use has been as a wash or gargle for sores and ulcerations of the mouth, throat, and stomach. Very similar in it's effects and actions as American Goldenseal ... Coptis is sometimes referred to as Chinese Goldenseal.

Red Clover, Wild Clover - According to many traditional herbalists, Red Clover is one of the best remedies for eczema, psoriasis, various skin rashes, coughs, bronchitis, skin sores and as a tonic to the liver and gallbladder. It has a long history in Europe as a cancer treatment and preventative. Externally, Red Clover may be used as a fomentation for rheumatic and gouty pains. Red Clover alterative properties make it an excellent blood cleanser combining well with other herbs to target particular organs or systems, and because it is mild, it makes an excellent nutritional supplement for children.

Red Clover has shown definite antibiotic and alterative properties in the laboratory. Antibiotic tests on the herb show it to possess activity against several bacteria, the pathogen that causes tuberculosis being the most significant. Red Clover has also shown some estrogenic activity in the course of routine laboratory testing; this effect is probably due to the presence of the plant-estrogen coumestrol.

Kudzu Root - In China, Kudzu is used both as a food and medicine. It is prescribed for colds, influenza, dysentery, snake and insect bites, croton oil poisoning and various drug and alcohol poisons. Externally, it has been used for the treatment of dog bites. Chinese herbalists have written that skin rashes have also been treated successfully with Kudzu. The skin is a primary organ of elimination just as the liver or kidney's. Kudzu's main function here is to keep the skin eliminating toxins at the proper rate. Remember that every eliminative organ must move 2 pounds of waste daily for optimum health. The skin must evaporate at least 2 pounds of water daily ... Kudzu insures that the skin has the support to do so.

Japanese Raisin Tree (Hovenia) - The Chinese attribute remarkable anti-vinous properties to this herb. It is said that after ingestion of large quantities of alcohol the herb will prevent any intoxicant or poisonous action. Hovenia has also been used as a laxative and for temporary relief of spasms. Restlessness, fevers, infantile convulsions and various poisonings have also been treated with this herb. The following is a copy of a summary abstract validating the ability of this herb to detoxify alcohol from the system.
